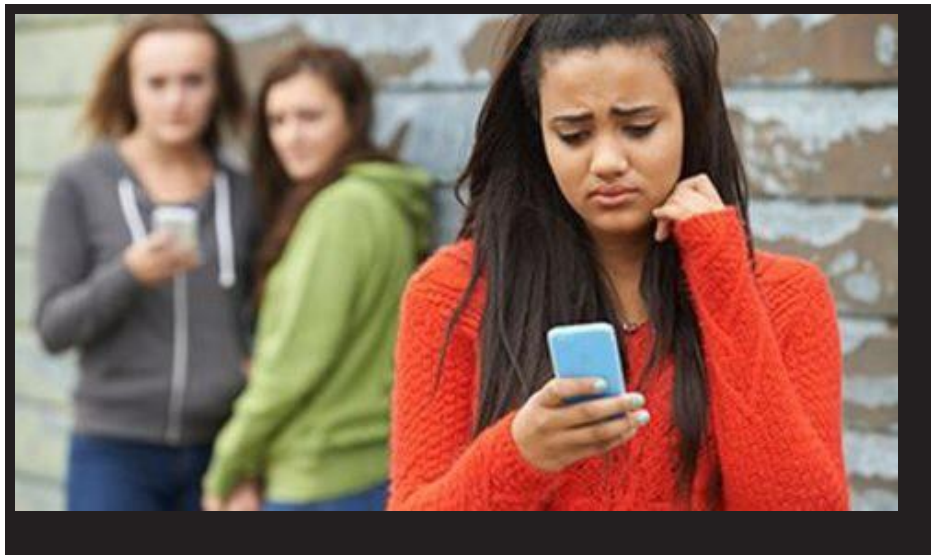

1. Go to www.CMGconnect.org/ and select your Diocese. Click “Go”.
