On a practical level, how does a parish begin to move towards the vision of lifelong faith formation within its existing programs of religious education? It is important to identify and put into action:

 ways to change the perception that catechesis is a program only for children to one of a process of lifelong faith formation;

 methods to move from the "school house model" in which catechesis is presented only as information to be learned in classroom settings;

 approaches to enhance the faith formation of adults of the parish in all gatherings and settings;

 the importance of the family and the parish community as valued and assisted role models and mentors for the passing on of the faith;

the role of catechesis for all ages as a moment of evangelization;

 the selection and presentation of catechetical materials so that faith can be incorporated according to age and ability; and

sensitivity to the cultures in which we live and receive faith.

But What do We Teach/Learn?

All catechesis should lead us towards the Sunday celebration of Liturgy within our community of faith. This celebration should open our hearts to a deeper understanding of the teachings of the Church and reveal the person and message of Christ. The facts of the faith are contained in the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

These Guidelines are not meant to be used as a textbook, but to emphasize the priority of faith formation for adults and to encourage the model of the six tasks of catechesis for learners across the life cycle. These Guidelines reflect the directions in catechesis put forth by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops in their recent and current documents:

A new resource for adult faith formation is found in the *United States Catholic Catechism for Adults*, issued in 2006. Resources for children and teens are found in the list of textbooks approved by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the Committee for Conformity to the Catechism. Within this list, there are series that are designed with a spiral scope and sequence. This design recognizes that the content of the church teachings are not mastered in a single year, but are taught and grasped each year at a deeper level and with an increased faith commitment. Lifelong catechesis honors our need for ongoing growth in faith.
