
Why should my parish invest in purchasing a license?

- OneLicense.net
 - ✓ Print License worship aid
 - ✓ Podcast Licensing any other media that is not print (Facebook, YouTube, Website, TV)

Subscriptions are on a yearly basis Cost is based on number of household

We have a small parish, under 50 families, why can't we purchase a missalette for every family and let them take them home?




In this time of the COVID-19 Pandemic, purchasing a license makes sense. Especially if you have a subscription to missalettes. Not being permitted to use them, this money is essentially going to waste.



❖If you feel you may have difficulty in affording a subscription, there are creative ways to find funding. Perhaps a parish organization: K of C, Altar Society, etc. or a family in memorial of a loved one would agree to donate the cost of a license.

*Any form of written or media communication for liturgical use must contain licensing notations.

How to Acknowledge ICEL Texts?

The copyright acknowledgment should include:

- *the name of the ICEL text,
- the copyright symbol,
- year of publication,
- ICEL's corporate title (may be abbreviated),
- and the phrase "all rights reserved."



ICEL Citations

For a *single* excerpt of ICEL texts the following should be printed after the text.

ICEL Citations

For multiple excerpts, the following must be printed on

- the inside front cover, or
- at the very end of the worship aid
- Excerpts from the English translation of The Roman Missal © 2010, International Commission on English in the Liturgy Corporation. All rights reserved.

ICEL Reprint Licensing

Publications for One-Time Use

- No royalty is charged for reprinting ICEL translations in a publication for use at a specific Mass or celebration of an individual congregation or institution.
- ICEL grants permission to those institutions or congregations reprinting its texts or music in publications for one-time use.

ICEL Reprint Licensing

Publications for More than One-Time Use

 No royalty is charged on publications for more than one-time use such as hymnals and other participation (worship) aids containing ICEL texts and produced by parishes or schools for their individual use, provided that the group printing this publication does not sell it.

HOWEVER

 Permission must be obtained from ICEL for the inclusion of ICEL texts in publications for more than one-time use.

USCCB Lectionary Reprint Licensing

YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO PRINT THE READINGS OUT EVERY WEEK WITHOUT A LICENSE FROM THE USCCB

- No written permission or fee is needed to reprint Mass readings for special, one-time liturgies (e.g. wedding Mass, confirmation Mass, etc.)
- The official texts must be used, and the appropriate acknowledgements must be printed beneath the readings
- Written permission and the appropriate license is needed for all other uses of the Lectionary texts

USCCB Lectionary Reprint Licensing

The Confraternity of Christian Doctrine (CCD) owns the copyright on the New American Bible, revised edition. The copyright protects the integrity of the text so that unauthorized changes are not introduced.

For parishes that regularly reprint the text of the Sunday readings in their worship aid, a reprint license is required, in addition to the music reprint license.

During these months of COVID 19, the USCCB allowed a grace period on licensing fees during the previous liturgical year, ending on November 28, 2020.

"As of November 29, 2020, licensing will again be required to reprint the readings for Sundays and major feasts in a digital or paper worship aid. To obtain a license, please send an email to nabperm@usccb.org with "Sunday Readings License" as the subject. Provide the parish name and address along with the number of copies you will produce (or the average number of downloads if digital). Staff will reply as soon as possible with a license which will serve as your invoice. Please mail a check to the address given on the invoice (along with a copy of the invoice itself) to complete the order." (from USCCB.com)

What about screens?

- The USCCB does not recommend the use of screens, however during the COVID pandemic, they seem to be effective.
- If you do use screens, all of the information contained in this presentation also applies.
 - Onelicense.net # has to be present on the screen
 - ICEL needs to be given credit for Mass texts (it is recommended only to project those parts of the Mass that may still be confusing to the congregation [i.e. Confiteor, Gloria, Nicene Creed].
 - Scripture readings must not be projected unless a license is purchased from the USCCB.






One License Song Lookup




Enter the song title



Or the hymnal and hymn






 Select the hymnal whose format best fits your needs (use the preview button to scan the layout and the text)






Review your list, then click "Download All" to download the files to your computer




Find the file in your computer Downloads



Select the type of file that fits your needs (TIF, Jpeg, TEXT, or PDF)


- Please note that PDFs can distort when enlarged or reduced in size.
- Right click on the file and select "Copy"






- Open your worship aid template and paste your song file in the desired location
- The full song file can be enlarged or reduced to fit your page space.
- You can use the "Crop" feature to remove the verses if you are only printing the Refrain.
- The song title and copyright information at the bottom should <u>ALWAYS</u> be included.
- Your One License license number (A-) should appear somewhere on your worship aid (usually at the end).

Report Usage



- Reprinted or streamed songs should be reported weekly for all music used from Thursday through Wednesday
- Only report copyrighted music here. Public Domain music does not need reported.
